

# East Taupo Lands Trust – Charitable Trust 2019 School Grant

## Information for Applicants

School Grants are available for eligible students attending New Zealand schools. Students can apply for one School Grant each school year. Where the Grant payment is made to the school, the Grant can be used towards; school fees and subscriptions, school activities and school trips, stationery and equipment and uniforms (where purchased at the school). It is up to the parent/caregiver to let the school know what school costs the Grant is to go towards.

## The 2019 School Grant per approved student is:

<b>Primary School \$40</b> Years 1 – 6	Grant is paid to the school to credit the student's school account <b>OR</b> receive a Warehouse Stationery Gift Card to buy school stationery
<b>Intermediate School \$50</b> Years 7 & 8	Grant is paid to the school to credit the student's school account
<b>Secondary School \$100</b> Years 9 – 13	Grant is paid to the school to credit the student's school account

For schools out of Taupo or Turangi include a copy of the school bank account deposit slip with the application.

## Application Closing Date

Applications close 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

For new entrants (year 1 and 0) who start school after 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019, applications close 15<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

## Grant Eligibility

Applicants and students must be owners or the descendants of owners of land vested in the East Taupo Lands Trust. Owners, applicants and students must reside in New Zealand. The Trust administers these blocks:

- Kaimanawa 1F, 2B
- Wharetoto 1, 2A, 2B, 3, 11
- Tapapa 3A, 3B1, 3B2
- Runanga 2C2A, 2C3B1, 2C3B2B, 2C3C, 2A, 2B, 2C1A, 2C1B, 2C1C, 2C1D

All relevant sections of the application form must be completed in full, signed, and have the required attachments. Failure to provide accurate details and / or complete this application correctly may result in your application being declined. Applicants will be notified by phone, email or letter if the grant has been approved or declined.
