## 2019 Tertiary Education Grant Application

Education Grants are available to assist with fees for students undertaking tertiary education in New Zealand. The following grants are based on full-time study (grants for part-time study will differ):

- Doctorate \$600
- University Diploma or Graduate Diploma \$400
- Multi-Year Certificate \$200
- Bachelor's Degree \$500
- Polytech Diploma \$200
- Other Certificate \$100

### Information for Applicants

1. Applicants must be owners, or the descendants of owners of land vested in this Trust. The owner and applicant must reside in New Zealand. The blocks administered by this Trust are:
  - Kaimanawa 1F, 2B
  - Tapapa 3A, 3B1, 3B2
  - Wharetoto 1, 2A, 2B, 3, 11
  - Runanga 2C2A, 2C3B1, 2C3B2B, 2C3C, 2A, 2B, 2C1A, 2C1B, 2C1C, 2C1D
2. First year students who are eligible for the Government 'fees free' scheme can not apply for an Education Grant in their first year of study.
3. Applicants can receive the Trust's Education Grant a maximum of two (2) times in their lifetime.
4. Applications will be considered throughout the year.
5. Approved grants will be paid once confirmation of course attendance has been verified. This may occur 6 - 8 weeks after a course commences and applicants may be responsible for arranging this.
6. Approved grants will either be paid direct to the course provider OR if course fees have been paid in full, the grant will be paid to the applicant's student loan via IRD. Payments will not be made to individuals.
7. Applicants will be advised of the outcome by email, phone, or letter. The Trustees' decision in respect of grants is final, and no reasons for granting or not granting funds will be given. Successful applicants are required to provide feedback to the Trustees regarding their course results.
8. The Trust is looking for commitment and focus from applicants and any supporting information should be provided to assist your application. There is no automatic right to a grant. Grants will be made subject to availability of funds and dependent on an assessment of the application. Where courses extend over more than one year, you must re-apply each year.
